NHS Pharmacy First Service

Pharmacies can offer prescription medicine for some conditions, without you needing to see a GP or make an appointment. This is called Pharmacy First. To see what conditions are covered, click on the link: www.nhs.uk/nhs-services/pharmacies/how-pharmacies-can-help/. There is no need to make an appointment; parents or carers can pop into their **local Boots pharmacy** with their child and ask for help under the service free of charge (unless NHS prescription charges apply).
