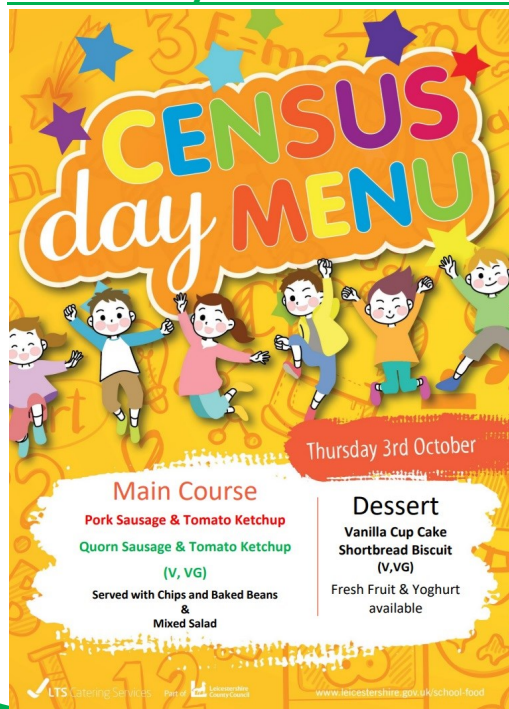


Drumba- Tuesday 15th October
