When it is your birthday, you are very welcome to wear your own clothes to school.

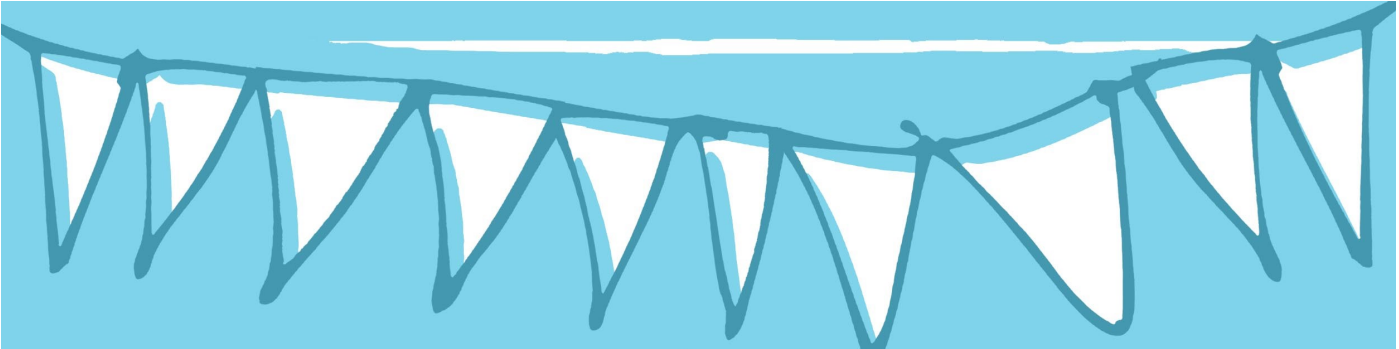
Earrings on PE days.
