WRAP-AROUND CHILDCARE

Our Breakfast club runs from 7:30am Monday to Thursday each morning and a healthy breakfast is included in the price. Every Friday, we run a gymnastics club from 7.50am. We also have our own after school club, which runs Monday - Friday. Please see our website for costs and times.

OUR SCHOOL

Our school is located in the beautiful village of Scalford, just minutes from Melton Mowbray. The building itself comprises of three classrooms, an office, and a fourth space used for teaching. We have use of the village hall and playing field for PE lessons and lunch times.

At the front of the school is an enclosed playground containing purpose built equipment. The playground is protected by a security gate. This area is also used throughout the day, for the outdoor play provision for our youngest pupils.

Scalford School has always had strong links with the parish church of St Eglewin.

The village provides a wonderful resource for both historical, environmental and geographical studies.



COMMUNITY

The Friends of Scalford School (our PTA) do a great deal to organise fund-raising events for the school and provide us with an essential source of income. All parents are very welcome to join. Informal meetings are held, usually in the village.

School is also well supported by the local community and our governors volunteers to support the children in their continued development.



SCHOOL MEALS

Our school meals are prepared and delivered by our catering team, Miquill. Children have a choice of a hot or cold lunch, or to bring a packed lunch from home. Universal Free School Meals are offered to children in Reception to Year 2. Meals are charged for, for children in years 3 - 6. Costs can be found on our website. Children on Pupil Premium are entitled to a free school lunch.

We have been awarded a 'Healthy School Accreditation' and as such we encourage children to eat healthy meals and have healthy snacks at playtimes. Lunchtimes take place at the village hall.

OUR CURRICULUM

We follow the National Curriculum but we also strive to maintain a wide, enriched programme of learning. We never lose sight of the fact that we are dealing with individuals.

Literacy and Numeracy are taught every day and skills learnt in these lessons are reinforced in all other areas of the curriculum. Science, Geography, History, RE, Design Technology, Music and Art are based around a rolling programme of topics, while a varied PE programme is also included.

WIDER CURRICULUM OPPORTUNITIES

Children are able to experience educational visits to a wide variety of places. In Years 5 and 6 we also offer Residential Trips.

There are a variety of clubs in which children can take part in throughout the year, including; multi-sports, football, gymnastics, dance, science and road safety, art, games.

All of our Church services such as Harvest, Easter and Christmas take place in St Eglewin's, where friends and family are invited.
